

INSTRUMENTATION

Reed I Piccolo, Flute, E_{flat} Clarinet (*double line Bb Clarinet*), B_b Clarinet, Soprano Saxophone, Alto Saxophone.

Reed II Piccolo (*double line Bb Clarinet*), Flute, Clarinet (*Soprano Saxophone opt., can be played by Bb Clarinet*), Alto Saxophone.

Reed III Oboe, English Horn (*double line Bb Clarinet*), B_b Clarinet, Tenor Saxophone.

Reed IV B_b Clarinet, Bass Clarinet, Bassoon (*double line Bass Clarinet*), Baritone Saxophone.

Horn (*when not available transposed for Trombone III*), Trumpet I-II, Trombone I, II (*Baritone Horn double opt.*), III (*opt. for Horn part*). Accordion-Celeste.


